

Workshop 2: E-portfolios

A webportfolio or e-portfolio is a website where you present yourself, your project work and competences to yourself and to internal and external stakeholders.

In this workshop you have to make two types of portfolios:

1. Presentation portfolio
2. Learning portfolio

The **presentation portfolio** is a website where you present yourself to e.g. fellow students, business partners, customers, potential employers.

When you plan the presentation portfolio it's a good idea to think about the following questions:

Who is the target group? What is the message? How do I want to use this presentation portfolio?

In this assignment the presentation-portfolio **could contain** some of the following elements:

- A short **presentation** of yourself incl. a picture.
 - Who you are and where you come from (e.g. a link to the google maps destination or subpage about your country)
 - What is your motivation for studying multimedia design in Denmark ?
 - Your interests
 - Contact information (Messenger, Skype, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn.....)
- Examples of your earlier **work**
- **Competences**
 - Your software skills (at the moment)
 - Your language skills
 - Your educational background
 - Experiences
 - Personal skills (Belbin role)
- Other things
 - Link to yours 5 favorite websites
 - Learningstyle

Requirements for the presentation-portfolio/website:

- *It shall be valid according to the XHTML 1.0 strict standard*
- *It shall contain at least 3 webpages.*

- *It shall use external and internal CSS*
- *The size of the homepage shall be under 100 kB*
- *The layout should work in the recent versions of Firefox and Internet Explorer*
- *The website shall be uploadet to a webserver (webhost).*

The **Learning portfolio** is a place where you **reflect** on what YOU learned from the different workshops and projects on the MMD program,

and on your motivation and interests i relation to MMD.

Requirements for the learning-portfolio:

- *Shall be made as an It's Learning ePortfolio*
- *Shall have a login (The login has to be submitted with this assignment !)*
- *Shall try to answers the question in this Demo example (password: matrix)*
